Students who meet any of the following may be eligible:

- Students who have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$0, as determined through the FAFSA process
- Students eligible for a state or federally financed work study during the regular school year, even if they are not currently participating in the program
- Students receiving Pell Grants
