Each farm or food business featured in this directory has been vetted for wholesale readiness, and individual profiles offer details about delivery, ordering, sourcing, contact information and more. By bringing together information that is most useful to prospective wholesale buyers, we hope to streamline the process of finding and making connections to sources of local food.

# About this Directory

## Vetting for Wholesale Readiness

To be listed in this directory, producers were vetted by the following wholesale readiness standards:

- A willingness to work with, and a knowledge of, wholesale buyers' needs
- Up to date liability insurance
- Ability to offer bulk volumes and/or case sizes and wholesale volume pricing
- Product packaging and labeling that is both legally compliant and professional
- An ordering and distribution process
- Being in compliance with their farm or food business's FSMA status and all applicable laws and regulations that pertain to their food operation



## Sourcing & Traceability

On each of the producer profiles throughout this directory you will see a section called "Sourcing & Traceability" which intends to help you understand where each farm or food business is producing and/or sourcing their products from. Below are definitions for the sourcing and traceability attributes we've asked the producers to select from.

- **New Hampshire:** the farm or food producer sources and sells food that is grown, raised, produced, and/or caught in New Hampshire. Value added products contain greater than 51% of NH-grown products by volume.
- **New England:** the farm or food producer sources and sells food that is grown, raised, produced, and/or caught within the New England states. Value added products contain greater than 51% of NE-grown products by volume.
- **Outside of New England:** the farm or food producer offers products from outside the New England region.
- **Product origin traceable by state:** the farm or food producer can provide documentation to prove the state of origin of each of their products.



## Wholesale Scale

The term "wholesale" can represent a broad spectrum of purchasing relationships. Each producer has indicated their "wholesale scale" on their producer profile, based on the criteria laid out below.

**Small-Scale Wholesale:** The farm or food producer supplies accounts such as small restaurants, small retail locations, like local corner stores or farm stores, and early childhood education centers or nursing homes.

**Mid-Scale Wholesale:** The farm or food producer supplies accounts such as larger restaurants, food cooperatives and larger retail establishments, and K-12 schools.

**Large-Scale Wholesale:** The farm or food producer supplies accounts such as chain grocery stores, institutions, like universities and hospitals, and distributors.

# Purchase Agreements: Plan ahead for your local purchases

**Want to help build a strong and viable local food system?  
Here's a strategy that will benefit your menu planning efforts and our local farmers.**

## Let's talk about Purchase Agreements!

A Purchase Agreement is a commitment between a food producer and a wholesale buyer that outlines a production and purchasing relationship with each other: the buyer agrees to purchase a certain quantity of product over a certain period of time while the producer agrees to intentionally grow or produce that quantity for that buyer.

Although not legally binding, it is best practice for Purchase Agreements to be put in writing to provide clear and mutual documentation of understanding and partnership between the entities.

## How to Get Started

**Think about products** that you source consistently.

**Find a producer** that grows or produces those products in the directory who has indicated "interest in purchase agreements" in their producer profile.

**Reach out** and ask if they would be willing to enter into a Purchase Agreement with you.

**Set the terms** and craft the agreement!



## Agreeing on the expectations

The buyer and the producer should come to a shared understanding of everything that impacts their specific relationship and agreement. The following topics should be considered:

- Quantity
- Frequency and timeline of purchases
- Price point
- Insurance coverage
- Logistics of delivery
- Payment terms
- Certifications & growing practices
- Quality stipulations & packaging needs


